ON THE ENDING CIRCUIT BREAKER AND PHASED APPROACH TO RESUMING ACTIVITIES SAFELY

As Singapore exits Circuit Breaker effective June 2, 2020 and embarks on a three-phased approach to gradually resume activities safely and reopen the economy, the Philippine Embassy in Singapore wishes to advise the Filipino Community to strictly abide by the following guidelines of the Singapore government:

- Leave home only for essential activities, and always wear a mask when doing so.
- Persons age 60 years old and above should continue to stay at home
- Continue to telecommute or work from home if you can
- When going out for an essential activity (including money remittance, grocery shopping, buying food or other necessities), avoid days and times of expected crowds and long queues. Return home immediately after performing the essential activity.
- Follow safe distancing measures strictly.
- Limit your direct contact with others. Non-essential activities and social gatherings are still prohibited.

Thank you for your cooperation in making Singapore a safer place for everyone.
