



## EMBASSY ADVISORY

The Philippine Embassy reiterates the following advisory from the Ministry of Manpower (MOM) to all our kababayans in Singapore working as Foreign Domestic Workers (FDW):

- FDWs must continue to stay at home during their rest days, go out only to do errands and buy meals, and return home immediately thereafter. Always wear a mask, maintain a safe distance of at least one metre away from others, and should not meet up with friends or gather in public areas to minimize contact with others.
- FDWs were observed crowding at places, such as City Plaza, Lucky Plaza and Peninsular Plaza, to either remit money or meet with friends. FDWs should not loiter or gather in groups, and return home immediately after doing their errands. Government authorities and safe distancing ambassadors will continue to be on guard to take firmer actions, including issuing warnings and revoking the work permit of FDWs who disregard MOM's advisory.
- Licensed remittance agents in City Plaza, Lucky Plaza and Peninsula Plaza will only serve customers by appointment on Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays. Customers should obtain an appointment first before remitting money in these areas. Employers are also advised to remind their FDW on the need to set an appointment to remit money at these locations.
- FDWs who are unable to get an appointment to personally remit money at these locations are encouraged to use e-remittance options or visit a remittance agent at another location.
