



Advisory on Foreigners Allowed to Enter the Philippines Starting 1 August 2020

The Philippine Embassy in Singapore advises the public that starting 01 August 2020, the Philippines will allow entry into its territory the following:

- 1) Foreign nationals and their dependents who are holders of any of the following visas:
 - 13 quota, 13A, 13B, 13C, 13D, 13E, 13G
 - Long term visa issued under RA 7919 and EO 324
 - Native born visa
- 2) Indian nationals who are holders of a temporary resident visa, *and*
- 3) Chinese nationals married to Filipinos who are holders of a permanent resident visa.

The entry of foreign nationals who are holders of abovementioned visas is subject to the following conditions:

- With pre-booked accredited quarantine facility;
- With pre-booked COVID-19 testing provider; and,
- Limitation on the number of inbound international passengers per day.
