



ADVISORY FOR AIR PASSENGERS ON TRANSIT THROUGH SINGAPORE

The Philippine Embassy in Singapore advises all Filipino air travellers that the Singapore Government policy for transit through Changi Airport is as follows:

- a) Travellers are allowed to transit through Singapore Changi Airport only if they are coming from an approved departure city. Please visit <https://www.singaporeair.com/saar5/pdf/media-centre/210106-TableforCitiesApprovedforTransit.pdf> for the list of departure cities approved for transit flights through Singapore.
- b) Transfers are only allowed between airlines within the SIA Group (Singapore Airlines, Silk Air and Scoot). Singapore Airlines also has approved interline agreements with Air France and KLM Royal Dutch Airlines, Garuda Indonesia, Lufthansa and Swiss International Airlines which allow their customers to transit through Singapore from approved cities to destinations in the SIA Group network operated by Singapore Airlines and SilkAir. **Transfers to and from flights operated by other airlines are currently not allowed.**
- c) Passengers may book a return flight through Singapore only if both the point of origin and the final destination are in the list of cities approved for transit through Singapore.

** Due to regulatory requirements, transfers to destinations in Mainland China are currently not allowed.

***Cities approved for transit flights must be your first point of departure. The exceptions are if your first point of departure is for a domestic flight, or if you are departing from a country in the Schengen area to connect to a SIA flight that is departing from another Schengen country.

****Do note you will not be able to transit through Singapore if you had to transfer through another country from your city of departure before transiting at Changi Airport. For example, Dublin – London – Singapore – Sydney is not allowed.
