TERMS OF REFERENCE

PROJECT:

PROCUREMENT OF WORK INJURY COMPENSATION FOR THE LOCAL HIRE EMPLOYEES OF THE PHILIPPINE EMBASSY IN

SINGAPORE FOR CY 2023

I. RATIONALE

The Embassy of the Republic of the Philippines in Singapore needs to procure a Work Injury Compensation Insurance Coverage for its locally-hired employees of the Embassy for CY 2023 for the sixteen (16) locally-hired employees of the Philippine Embassy in Singapore as required by the Ministry of Man Power.

II. OBJECTIVE

- 2.1 To get a comprehensive work injury compensation insurance for the Embassy's sixteen (16) locally-hired employees which comply with the requirements of the Ministry of Manpower of Singapore.
- 2.2 To ensure that all locally-hired personnel are given adequate work injury compensation insurance coverage while employed at the Philippine Embassy.

III. SCOPE OF INSURANCE COVERAGE

IV. PRICING

The offered quotation should be in Singapore Dollars, inclusive of GST and other lawful charges.

V. INVOICING and PAYMENT

- 5.1 The winning Contractor shall submit the invoice which includes GST for goods and services and original technical conformity document to the Embassy.
- 5.2 The following information must be indicated on the invoice(s):
 - Purchase Order Number;
 - Description, quantity and total;
 - · GST amount; and
 - Name of Payee / Company Name
 - Bank Information; Bank Name(s), Branch name(s), Account number(s)

5.3 Payment Terms

- The Contractor shall bill the Procuring Entity one time billing on January 2023
- The Contractor shall be paid by the Embassy on a one-time payment basis upon presenting proper due invoice;
- The Embassy shall pay the Contractor via cheque within seven (7) working days upon receipt of the bill. The provider shall issue the tax invoice immediately after payment.

VI. EVALUATION FACTORS

- The Contract shall be awarded to the lowest priced, acceptable and responsive bidder.
- The Embassy reserves the right to reject proposals that are unreasonably low or high in price.
- The Embassy shall determine Contractor's responsibility by analysing whether the apparent successful offeror complies with the requirements of Philippine Government including:
 - > adequate financial resources or the ability to obtain them;
 - ability to comply with the required performance period, taking into consideration all existing commercial and governmental business commitments:
 - > satisfactory record of integrity and business ethics;
 - > necessary organization, experience, and skills or the ability to obtain them:
 - necessary equipment and facilities or the ability to obtain them; and
 - > be otherwise qualified and eligible to receive an award under applicable laws and regulations.

VII. WARRANTY

The winning Contractor shall clearly identify and state the warranty period and be responsible and liable for providing the necessary remedies for defects, faults or shortages after the completion of the Project.

VIII. CONFIDENTIALITY CLAUSE

- All data are owned by the Procuring Entity. Data is defined as all information that is owned, licensed, or developed by or on behalf of the Procuring Entity, whether provided to the Provider by the Procuring Entity or provided by a third party to the Provider in connection with the Provider's provision of services to the Procuring Entity, including any such data files, tables, that is loaded into, or located in, any data files, tables, objects or other storage medium developed or maintained by or on behalf of Provider, including related data that results from hygiene, cleaning, and database build services performed by or on behalf of the Procuring Entity.
- All data provided by the Procuring Entity to the Provider or generated in connection with the performance of services toward the development and implementation of the Solution by the Provider and relating to the Procuring Entity or its personnel, whether in existence before the date of or its personnel, whether in existence before the date of the agreement hereof or thereafter in the course of implementing the solution, shall be treated by the Provider as the exclusive property of the procuring Entity or tits personnel.
- Upon the receipt of the notice of acceptance of proposal, the Provider is required to maintain confidentiality and security of the Procuring Entity's

data and is prohibited from using or attempt in using the Procuring Entity's data in any other manner or for any other purpose, except as necessary to the execution of the solution or perform its other obligations stated in the technical specification.

IX. DIPLOMATIC CLAUSE

The Embassy shall terminate the services of the Contractor by sending a written notice at least fifteen (15) days in advance by recorded delivery letter, in the event of the severance of the diplomatic ties between the Republic of Singapore and the Philippine Government.
