Filipinos whose marriage was solemnized by the Registry of Marriages of Singapore should register / report their marriage at the Philippine Embassy, Singapore, within a period of one year from the time of their marriage. Otherwise, an affidavit of late registration will be executed for such purpose.

- One (1) duly accomplished Report of Marriage form
- Three (3) photocopies of the marriage certificate
- Three (3) photocopies of the husband's passport
- Three (3) photocopies of the wife's passport
- Cash payment of Report of Marriage service fee of S\$42.50

For late registration

- Affidavit fee of S\$42.50

For applicants who were previously married and whose marriage was annulled by court

- Copy of the Court decision declaring the annulment of marriage duly authenticated by the DFA
- Copy of the marriage contract with the previous spouse with annotation of the annulment printed on security paper by the NSO and duly authenticated by the DFA

For applicants who is a widow or widower

- Death certificate of deceased spouse. If previous spouse died in the Philippines, the death certificate should be authenticated by the NSO in Manila and DFA.

For applicants whose foreign spouse is divorced

- Copy of the final decree of divorce

APPLICATION HOURS:

- Open Sundays to Thursdays (except Singapore & Philippine declared holidays)
- Submission of Applications at Window 8 from 2:00 to 4:00 pm
- Collection of document is after two (2) working days from 2:00 to 4:00 p.m.
