Any interested party may file a written opposition to the above approved accreditations within five (5) days, or until 13 April 2025, 5:00 P.M., pursuant to Section 11 of [COMELEC Resolution 11082](#), citing the grounds thereof, and duly substantiated with supporting documents.

Accredited media representatives are reminded that media coverage shall be conducted in a manner that does not disrupt the voting process, and must comply with the guidelines under [COMELEC Resolution 11082](#), including the following rules of conduct:

1. Respect the authority of COMELEC-deputized personnel;
2. Uphold the ballot secrecy rule at all times;
3. Respect the privacy of the electorate;
4. Maintain professionalism, impartiality, and objectivity in the fulfillment of their objectives;
and
5. Ensure that any public exchange of information must be accurate, fair, and thorough.

This advisory is issued in the interest of transparency and in support of responsible media coverage during the conduct of Overseas Voting in Singapore.
