



PH EMBASSY LAUNCHES ONLINE PRE-VERIFICATION SYSTEM FOR OVERSEAS VOTING

25 MARCH 2022

The **Overseas Voting for the 2022 Philippine National Elections**, which will be held from **10 April to 9 May 2022**, is fast approaching. To make the voting process faster, more convenient and safer for all *kababayans* who are registered voters in Singapore, the Philippine Embassy is happy to announce the launch of an **online pre-verification system** that they can avail themselves of during the 30-day voting period.

The online pre-verification system may be accessed through this link:

After registering on the system, registrants will receive an email from the Embassy within 1 to 3 working days, confirming the inclusion of their names in the Certified List of Voters (CLOV). They will also receive their assigned precinct number as well as some reminders for voting a few days before their chosen schedule.

The use of an online pre-verification system aims to ensure a safer, more convenient and more orderly conduct of overseas voting by reducing the queue waiting time at the Embassy. Voters who have pre-registered will be able proceed directly to their precinct to vote without having to undergo the verification process.

The use of this online pre-verification system is **optional**. Walk-in voters will still be accommodated. However, please expect a longer waiting time to vote during your visit to the Embassy if you have not been pre-verified.

- 1 Go to bit.ly/SGPE_Halalan2022 and follow the given instructions.
- 2 Choose your preferred date and time to vote at the Philippine Embassy.
- 3 Supply the requested information.
- 4 Wait for the email confirmation to be sent to your registered e-mail address within 1 to 3 working days.
- 5 Be ready with your valid Philippine passport and email confirmation when you go to the Embassy on your chosen voting date and time.



Walk-in registered voters will still be accommodated. However, please expect a longer waiting time to vote during your visit to the Embassy if you have not pre-verified.
