IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PHILIPPINE E-VISA SYSTEM IN SINGAPORE

The Philippine Embassy informs the public on the implementation of the Philippine e-Visa system in Singapore effective today, **Monday, 23 June 2025**.

Coverage

1. The e-Visa system will accommodate **applications from residents of Singapore** for temporary visits to the Philippines for **tourism or business purposes ONLY**, under the following categories:
 - a. single-entry 9(a) e-Visas;
 - b. multiple-entry 9(a) e-Visas valid for six (6) months; or
 - c. multiple-entry 9(a) e-Visas valid for one (1) year.
2. Foreign nationals who intend to visit the Philippines for studies, employment, and other purposes not covered above are still required to apply for a regular visa sticker at the Philippine Embassy.
3. The existing **no-visa policy** for tourism purposes for holders of passports from several countries, including **Singapore**, remains in effect.

Nationals of Singapore may enter the Philippines without a visa for tourism purposes, provided their stay does not exceed 30 days. They must also hold a valid return ticket to their country of origin or onward destination and a passport valid for at least six (6) months beyond their intended stay.

Procedure

1. If you fall under category (1) above, you may apply remotely via the official Philippine e-Visa website: evisa.gov.ph at your convenient time.

2. Submission of original documents and personal appearance/interview will **no longer be mandatory** for e-Visa applications. However, the Philippine Embassy reserves the right to require the submission of original documents or to request the applicant's personal appearance and/or interview **if further scrutiny of the application is deemed necessary**.
3. Payment of [e-Visa fees](#) can be made online through direct bank transfer. Please note that your application will not be processed by the system unless payment is received. No reimbursements will be made for unsuccessful applications.
4. Once issued by the Embassy, the e-Visa can be accessed remotely using personal computers, laptops, or mobile devices, and can be presented in either digital or printed form. The e-Visa will no longer be physically affixed to passports.
5. The e-Visas issued are not valid for conversion to other types of Philippine visas, and their authorized period of stay are not valid for extension.
6. The standard processing time of e-Visa applications is **7-12 working days for single entry visas and 15-21 working days for multiple entry visas**.
7. The e-Visa holders are reminded to accomplish the online Philippine **e-Travel registration** form at etravel.gov.ph **only after** the issuance of the e-Visa by the Philippine Embassy to avoid any inconvenience at Philippine ports of entry.
