



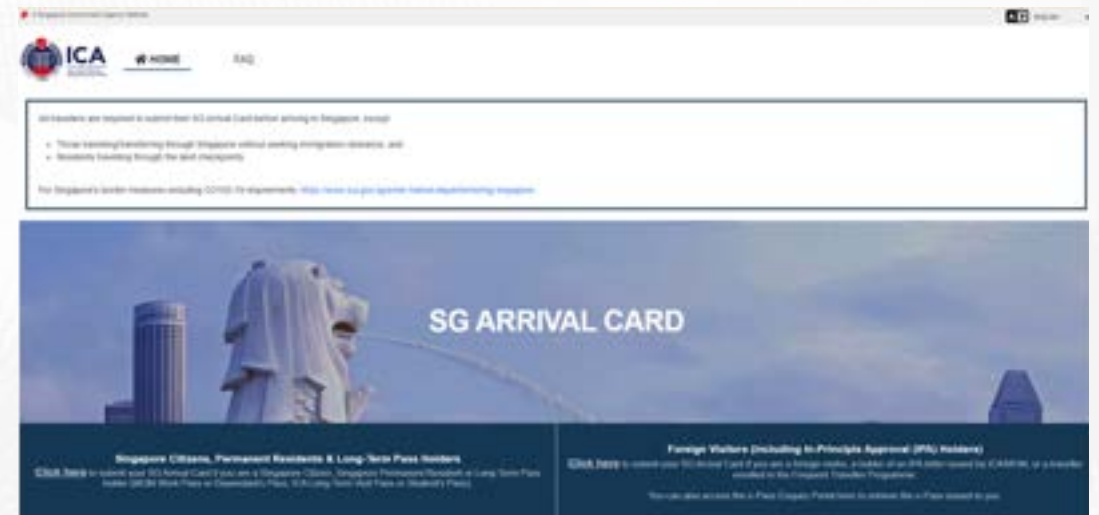

Reminder to All Travellers: Submit SG Arrival Card 3 Days Prior to Arrival in Singapore

The Immigration & Checkpoints Authority (ICA) has issued an advisory on 21 December 2022 reminding all travellers, including Singapore residents (Singapore citizens, permanent residents and Long-Term Pass holders (*i.e. Student's Pass, Dependant's Pass, Work Pass and Long-Term Visit Pass Holders*)), **to submit the SG Arrival Card within three days** (arrival day included) before arriving in Singapore to avoid inconvenience. This can be done through the ICA's website or MyICA mobile application. This is **FREE** of charge and will only take less than three (3) minutes for Singapore residents, or five (5) to seven (7) minutes for foreigners.

Travellers who have not submitted their SG Arrival Card upon arrival at the immigration counter will be asked to do so and thereafter **re-join the queue** for immigration clearance.

Furthermore, travellers with changes in their health condition or travel history must **re-submit** their health declaration form before arriving in Singapore. Those who make false declarations will be liable for prosecution under Singapore's Infectious Diseases Act.

Only the following are **exempted** from SG Arrival Card submission:

- (i) Travellers who are transiting/transferring through Singapore without seeking immigration clearance; and
- (ii) Singapore residents travelling by land through the Woodlands and Tuas checkpoints.

The SG Arrival Card is part of ICA's move towards paperless immigration clearance under the New Clearance Concept. It replaces the paper-based disembarkation/embarkation card that foreign visitors were previously required to submit upon arrival at ICA checkpoints.
