

## IATF Resolution No. 144-A Validation of Vaccination Status of Returning OFWs and Non-OFWs

On October 14, 2021, the IATF released IATF-EID Resolution No. 144- A.

For OFWs and Non-OFWs Vaccinated Abroad. For purposes of validating vaccination status, OFWs and their spouse, parents, and/or children travelling with them, who were vaccinated abroad, and Non-OFWs vaccinated abroad, may present any of the following:

- 1. Their National/State Digital Certificate of the foreign government where they were vaccinated, without the need of a reciprocity agreement;
- 2. Vaccination Certificates issued by any of the states of the United States of America, whether digital or physical;
- 3. Vaccination Certificates issued by the Center for Disease Control and Prevention. whether digital or physical;
- 4. Vaccination Certificates issued by any of the provinces and territories of Canada, whether digital or physical.
- 5. For Singapore, validation of Vaccination Certificates by POLO is no longer required, except for those who are not able to present a National Digital Certificate (with QR code) issued by notarise.gov.sg.

OFWs who are **not** able to present a National Digital Certificate (with QR code) issued by notarise.gov.sg must submit clear copies of the following documents via email to polosgyaccinationverif@yahoo.com:

- 1. Information Page of their Philippine Passport;
- 2. Identification Card/Work Permit/ S-Pass/E-Pass/Special Visit Pass/ Dependent Pass; and
- Vaccination Record/Vaccine Card.

POLO-Singapore shall validate the Vaccine Record/Vaccine Card and electronically transmit the validated copy to the OFW for presentation to the Bureau of Quarantine (BOQ) Desk at the airport.
