Adjustment in Fees for Passport Validity Extension

The Embassy would like to inform the public that effective 1 December 2021, (Wednesday), the fee for extension of validity of regular passports will be changed from SGD34 to SGD42.50.

This is pursuant to Department Order No. 2021-016 and Foreign Service Circular 2021-015 dated 15 October 2021 of the Department of Foreign Affairs (DFA) on the schedule of fees for passport services. This is also in line with Section 16 of Republic Act No. 8239 or the "Philippine Passport Act of 1996" which states that "reasonable fees shall be collected for the processing, issuance, extension, amendment or replacement of a lost passport... as may be determined by the Department [of Foreign Affairs]", and Section 87 of Republic Act No. 7157 or the "Philippine Service Act of 1991" expressly allowing the DFA and the Secretary of Foreign Affairs to periodically review all existing administrative rules and regulations implementing the provisions of the Act.

The schedule of fees for all other Embassy services remains unchanged.
