



ADVISORY ON TRAVEL TO THE PHILIPPINES GIVEN THE THREAT POSED BY THE OMICRON VARIANT

The Philippine Embassy in Singapore informs the public of the following updates regarding travel to the Philippines, pursuant to [IATF Resolution Number 151-A](#) dated 28 November 2021:

1. Testing and quarantine protocols for countries/jurisdictions/territories classified previously as “Green” **are temporarily suspended**.
 - [IATF Resolution No. 150-A](#) dated 25 November 2021 initially allowing visa-free entry fully vaccinated nationals of non-visa required countries under Executive Order No. 408 (s. 1960) included in the “**Green**” list has been revoked.
2. Except for countries classified as “Red,” testing and quarantine protocols for all inbound international travellers in all ports of entry shall comply with the testing and quarantine protocols for “**Yellow**” list countries/jurisdictions. More details can be found [on this link](#).
3. In view of the emerging threat posed by the COVID-19 omicron variant* and the growing number of COVID-19 cases reported in these countries**, all travellers who have been to the following “**Red**” list countries in the past 14 days are barred from entering the Philippines, effective 28 November until further notice:
