The Philippine Embassy in Singapore would like to inform the public that Filipino nationals who currently live or work near Singapore (e.g. Johor Bahru, Batam) or are registered in another Embassy or Consulate and with active registration status, but find themselves in Singapore during this month-long period (April 9 to May 9, 2016), may exercise their right to vote at the Philippine Embassy in Singapore.

The procedure is as follows:

1. Concerned Filipinos would first need to fill up the attached "Manifestation of Intention to Vote" and email it back to the Embassy at oav.sgpe@gmail.com.
2. Embassy will verify your voting records by communicating with COMELEC.
3. Once a positive response has been given by COMELEC, we will then email you to proceed to the Philippine Embassy, Singapore at the following address and times:


Time: Monday to Sunday (weekends and public holidays)
9am to 5pm

4. Proceed to verification counter with a copy of your email from the Philippine Embassy, Singapore, and your valid Philippine Passport.
5. Once verified, please proceed to SBEI 8.
